Counting: Think about your targets (count in 2,5,10, 3,4) Count forwards and backwards from different starting points eg:- Start on 12 and count on in 2s: 12,14,16,18,20 Start on 30 and count back in 5's: 30,25,20,15,10,5,0 Write down your numbers - what do you notice about the numbers? Introduction/title What they look like(include a labelled diagram) What do they eat? Special features or talents. Where do they live?
