

Monday	Jolly phonics https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=1Qpn2839Kro	Count the fruit as you read/watch the story. How many strawberries did he eat? Did he eat more strawberries than pears? Did he eat less apples than plums? Etc. Yesterday?
Tuesday	Count to 20 clapping as you count (don't forget to start with zero). Count up to 10 and back to zero, pointing at and saying numbers as you count.	Make your own caterpillar using play dough, painting paper plates or use finger painting. How many sections did you give his body? What shape are they?
